Who says the little guys can't successfully compete and win the big prizes in the world of pleasure horses? Who says you must be wealthy to be able to afford to show at the big shows on a national level? And who says you have to be one of the "good ole boys" to own and fill the book of a great young stallion? Not the Bailey's in Batavia, Ohio. With relatively few years on the show circuit and just a few show horses, they have achieved what takes most people a lifetime, including three AQHA World Championships in as many World Championship shows, a Congress Championship and Reserve Championship, an Equistat #1 Money Earner, numerous futurity championships and NSBA Year End awards.

The Bailey's first got into horses to trail ride with friends. Becky thought it would be a good wholesome family activity and a way to keep her nine-year-old daughter, Jessica, in the barn and out of trouble as she went through her teenage years. They spent the first several years in 4-H and showing in open shows. It was not until late in 1999 that they bought their first futurity horse, Krymsun Hot Invite, a mare that was purchased for them by their trainer while watching the Congress

Longe Line. One thing led to another. Becky bought the filly's dam and her yearling full brother, One Hot Krymsun, in 2000. Then in 2001, the Bailey's showed in NSBA shows, and got the opportunity to meet people and introduce themselves and their new and growing program to the pleasure horse circuit. It was definitely a magical year that ended in One Hot Krymsun winning the 2 Year-Old Snaffle Bit Pleasure World Championship. The Bailey's didn't retire One Hot Krymsun. Instead they sent him on to win the Congress 3 Year-Old Snaffle Bit Derby and then to top that by winning the Junior Western Pleasure World Championship. And by the following January, his book was filled and closed before his first foal ever hit the ground.

But the Bailey's still don't consider themselves in the elite of the pleasure horse world. "We are just normal horse owners that have been fortunate to own some great horses and put them with talented trainers," says Becky Bailey. The Bailey's hope their Cinderella story will encourage others to believe that they can win big prizes if they put their minds to it. Becky will be the first to admit that this kind of success doesn't come without hard work and setting high goals. Each December, she and her daughter, Jessica, now eighteen, make up a list of things they would like to accomplish in the next year. It is usually just a hand-written list that gets tacked up on the cork board. As they accomplish something, they cross it off the list. Becky nearly caught herself trying to get Jess to be more realistic when she wrote on her list to "Win the AQHYA World Championship in Western Pleasure." "I had to bite my tongue, and I, of all people, should know the power of setting goals," said Becky. Sure enough, this past August, Jessica achieved her goal with Zips Chocolate Swirl, went home with a World Championship, and scratched that goal off the list.

What is ahead for the Bailey's in 2004 and beyond? They have great plans and visions of seeing One Hot Krymsun foals achieve success in the show pen, building the best set of broodmares in the pleasure horse industry, meeting new people and making new friends. Most importantly, they plan on having fun.
